PATIENTS

with high out of pocket costs often pay more than their drug's negotiated discount price when picking up their medicine at the pharmacy

When seniors pickup their medicines at the pharmacy, the cost at the register is often higher than the drug's actual price. That's because deep manufacturer-negotiated discounts and rebates don't always make their way to patients. CMS' new proposed rule for Medicare Part D has a request for information on how to address this.
