

Pneumococcal Vaccines Survey



In February we conducted a poll of more than 1100 older Americans who identify as concerned about healthcare during retirement, 98% of whom are over the age of 50 and 78% who are 65 and older.

A CDC panel is considering changing the current recommendation for a pneumococcal vaccination for adults aged 65+ which would mean fewer seniors could receive vaccinations through insurance. Adults we surveyed think this is a dangerous idea.
