- H.R. 19 Lower Costs, More Cures Act
- H.R. 153 Protecting Consumer Access to Generic Drugs
- Ы, Д. 1857 Protecting Access to Safe and Effective Medicines
- H.R. 3682 Improving Transparency to Loser Drug Costs Act
- H.R. 4918 Rural Telehealth Expansion Act
- H.R. 4890/S. 2576 Rush Act
- H.R. 341 Ensuring Telehealth Expansion Act
- S. 149 Bill to amend Title XI of Social Security Act

We are continuing to monitor H.R. 3 and have done strong lobbying to defeat this bill. We would like to recognize the following House members who have agreed to vote no: Rep. Scott Peters (CA), Rep. Kathleen Rice (NY), and Rep. Kurt Schrader (OR).




